120/16 To resolve approval of the minutes of the meeting held on 8 February

It was **resolved** to confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 8 February, and these were signed by the Chairman.

121/16 Update from Safer Neighbourhoods Policing Team

PCSO J. May said there had been six beach hut break-ins, and urged owners to check their locks. Other offences during the month included 2 Criminal Damage, 1 Shoplifting, 8 Violence to the person, 8 domestic and 4 making off without paying. She hoped to introduce Sgt Lee Rolf at the next meeting.

123/16 To discuss the status of Cliff Path

Residents of Cliff Path (the section between the Railway Station and Lake Cliff Gardens), which is legally a footpath, spoke of their concerns regarding the road surface, speeding and turning. The Clerk would report to Island Roads, but residents were urged to make their own reports as well.

124/16 To review the Parish Council's risk assessment

It existing document was reviewed and on a proposal by D. Hardy, seconded by Mrs S. Horton, it was **resolved** to add an item covering third party payroll provider theft.

125/16 To resolve any support for Broadlea School crossing patrol

There was some sympathy for the school's predicament (tempered to some extent by frustration that this came after we had set our budgets and precepts for the next financial year). Members could not work out whether the current agreement with IW Council expires on 31 March or at the end of the school year in July. Although recognising that we may well wish to make a contribution, Members asked the Clerk to establish if the school had written to nearby 'big players' seeking other contributions (Morrisons, Aldi, Top Mops - they might see it to their community advantage to be associated with a good news story). Given it is a parental responsibility to get their offspring to and from the school gate, is there a PTA that could canvass contributions from concerned parents? Could a Puffin crossing replace the existing zebra crossing?

126/16 To consider possible support: Lake Day and Man Shed

Cllr White said he had been in touch with Sandown & Lake Football Club, who were about to get a new container on site at Fairway Park and would consider making the old one available for the Man Shed project. Swintons were prepared to offer insurance assistance. It was noted that Age UK were already providing a Man Shed at Winchester House. The Chairman would liaise with the Lions Club concerning the possible Lake Day on 23 September.
